Steps to Enroll in the Texarkana College Adult Education & Literacy Program

Each step MUST be completed before students are able to move forward!

- 1. Complete Enrollment Paperwork Online (or come by the office for a paper copy)
 - Go to the Texarkana College Adult Education and Literacy Program page https://www.texarkanacollege.edu/academics/learn/adult-education-literacy/#block_6201a07539509
 - Student will need a photo ID or birth certificate and social security number.
 - 17- and 18-year-old students must have a school withdrawal and a parent/guardian signature.
- 2. Complete the TABE 11/12 Assessment in reading, math, and language.
 - Take the assessment at the Texarkana College Adult Education Program on the TC Campus (corner of Tucker St. and Johnson Ave.).
 - The assessment will be given two days at the beginning of the month. Call the program
 for dates and times. (3-hour minimum testing time, so please arrive on time) The
 student MUST schedule an appointment for testing. Jan. 3 or Jan. 10
 - The student must contact the program via email or phone 903 823 3460 or 903 823 3462 to schedule a testing session.
- 3. Attend a virtual Academic Enrichment Session on Zoom
 - Attendance is required for student to begin the program. Jan. 17 or Jan. 18
 - The orientation will be offered the week prior to starting class on one morning and one
 evening for two hours.
- Begin classes. Jan. 23
 - Classes begin monthly (usually the last week of the month).
